He stated, “It is known by either many people or no one. Gorey was a man of wonderful contradictions.” There were over 25,000 books in the house, which were moved to California. There were 10,000 visitors that were greeted last year at the house. It is a fluid museum that reflects Edward’s personality. He was a person that was hard to pin down and the museum strives to show a different way to look at him each year. “He loved things that walked the boundary between useful and deteriorated,” stated Hischak. He loved Agatha Christy and the 1930s style of murder mysteries. He is “great to read if you let go and don’t expect a beginning, end, and snippets. It is one of the most unique museums in the country. It is playing with history, playing with facts, and playing with creativity.” He invited everyone to visit the museum, bring guests, and visit often!
