The Main Event

GUEST SPEAKER: ANNA YUEN, OUT-BOUND ROTARY EXCHANGE STUDENT (2015-16)

In her introduction of **Anna Yuen** – Outbound Rotary Exchange Student to Taiwan – **Chantal Rice** recounted how the Yarmouth Rotary came to be sponsoring a student from Norwood, MA, as a courtesy to the Norwood Rotary Club, as well as for **Anna** and her family. It has been an outstanding successful exchange student experience; and **Anna** was on hand, along with her mother, to thank the Yarmouth Rotarians (the opportunity was “priceless”) and to present an overview of her life-changing year.

Anna spent her Rotary exchange year in the capital city of Taipei (Rotary District 3480) with three very warm and close-knit host families. The city is home to three Rotary districts, who hosted a combined total of 64 Rotary exchange students from around the world. She presented a Power-Point view of a number of events that highlighted her year, including • the School Fair, • a Halloween Party, • the month-long celebration of the New Year, • a March tour of Taiwan’s aboriginal community and culture, • an April student trip to Japan and Tokyo’s Disneyland, and • a group tour in May for both inbound and outbound student of coastal cities, beaches, landscapes, and hikes.

She contrasted the some of the school differences with American counterparts: strict rule following, less independent, tighter knit; but the people and the students were “so open.” When asked about contrasts with her own family background (her parents were born in Hong Kong), **Anna** revealed such differences as her Cantonese speaking with their Mandarin; plus, being an American, she found that initially they expected a student who was “blond and blue-eyed”! **Anna** provided an emphatic affirmative to the Yarmouth Rotary’s decision to embrace her student exchange opportunity.
