
The Main Event

GUEST SPEAKER: YARMOUTH FIRE CHIEF PHILIP G. SIMONIAN III

Janice Matheson introduced the newly appointed Yarmouth Fire Chief Phil Simonian. While the "appointment" as Chief is new, Phil Simonian was the Acting Fire Chief upon the medical leave of his predecessor, under whom he served as Deputy Chief. (One town government observer noted that the "transition was better than seamless.")

Phil's first interest in the fire service began at a very young age while living in Arlington, MA. His grandfather's oil company was very close to the Arlington Fire Headquarters, where he spent a lot of time. In 1975, his family moved to Yarmouth, and he attended the John Simpkins Elementary School, starting in the 3rd grade. His interest in firefighters continued. He joined the Yarmouth Fire Department May 1983, when he turned sixteen, as a call firefighter. In 1980, he was hired as a full-time firefighter when Station 2 on Route 6A became staffed twenty-four hours a day.

Phil graduated from D-Y (1985), University of New Haven (Bachelor's degree, Fire Science / Fire Investigation, 1989), and Anna Maria College (Master's degree, Fire Based Public Administration, 2010). He maintains memberships in several local, state, and New England professional associations; and also serves on local, county, and regional committees involving mutual aid, emergency planning, shelter management, and hazardous materials.
