As **Lorna** outlined, "Up with People was founded in 1969 on the principle of using music as a means to communicate with and inspire people. In each city we visit, Up with People cast members perform a vibrant and inspiring musical stage show that brings the community together to enjoy a night of entertainment while sparking people to take action in meeting the needs of their communities, countries and the world."

GUEST SPEAKER: SARAH JANE PORTER, ARCHITECT

In his introduction, Charlie Adams used the adjective "outstanding" to characterize the professional qualities that Sarah Jane Porter has brought to her career as an architect as well as her membership on Yarmouth's Design Review Committee. It was soon became apparent how apt was his choice of words. While most of her work now is in residential, her insight and knowledge gleaned from 33 years on Cape Cod – and 20 vears right on Route 6A – has given Sarah Jane Porter great opportunity to contribute to the blend of historical, pragmatic, and commercial elements that come together locally on much the Cape.

She presented a shortened version of her well-known and indepth discussion of the architecture of "The Cape" (from Full and Half Capes to Capes with overlays of styles from Federal, Gothic Revival, Italianate, etc.).
