Tammy Glivinski introduced Guest Speaker, Wendy Northcross, Chief Executive Officer of the Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce. Wendy has been with the organization since 1971. During her tenure as the Executive Director of the Hyannis Area Chamber of Commerce, Wendy was a cofounder of the John F. Kennedy Hyannis Museum; and she continues to serve on its Board of Trustees as Vice Chair.

She also serves on the Executive Committee of the Arts Foundation of Cape Cod as well as the Boards of Directors of the Cooperate Bank of Cape Cod, the Cape & Islands Workforce Investments Board, and the Job Training & Employment Corporation. She is a D-Y graduate and a member of the Rotary Club of Hyannis. Her husband, Van Northcross (also a Hyannis Rotarian), is Regional Director of marketing and government relations for Cape Cod Healthcare.

Wendy outlined some of the historical aspect of the Cape Cod Chamber (founded in 1922) and of the economic events that have greatly affected living and working here. The Chamber, in addition to being the marketing arm for the Cape, plays a major role in strategic thinking and planning around the major issues of the environment, open space, historical considerations, technology & education, governance, and promotion.
