The Main Event

Rising Star Dennis Liu - Nicole D'Erico, a Guidance Counselor from DY, introduced today's Rising Star, Dennis Liu. She described Dennis as a natural leader who welcomes all students with the daily announcements. She said this really sets the tone for the student body each day. He does not sit on the sidelines, but instead, rolls up sleeves and dives right in. He has organized service projects and programs and thinks outside the box, not just looking for the easy answer. He is involved in Student Government, and comes from a creative background representing the student body. He was selected as drum major and formed a "pizza" club where students gather device-free and simply engage in discussion.

Dennis addresses the club and read excerpts from an essay he wrote entitled, "What Does DY Pride Mean to Me?" He said, "I can say with full confidence that I will succeed in life because of what DY has provided to me." He participates as the student representative on the school board committee. He closed by stating, "Collaboration among a diverse group of students has provided many teaching moments. All those kids are facing their own hardships and persevering through it."







Guest Speaker – Carole Connolly, Executive Director of Cape Mediation – Carole has been the executive Director since 2012 of Cape Mediation. One of the most difficult and trying things in life is conflict. She introduced the club to the quote by Tim Scudder, "You don't have to attend every conflict you are invited to." She introduced the concept of listening by truly not talking. You can listen to someone and hear their side of the story and not necessarily need to agree. Communication is visual, audial, and verbal, so it is important to listen. In her presentation, she had 7 different people read a sentence and emphasize a different word in the sentence. It was clear that there were different meanings with the same sentence depending on which word was emphasized. Carole's suggestion to the group that if 3 emails pass back and forth between two people and there is not a mutual understanding, then it is time to pick up the phone of walk down the hall to verbally communicate.

Cape Mediation provides no fee mediation services, which is offered at Cape Cod's 4 different courts. The agreement rate for those who voluntarily choose mediation is 80%. Those who choose not to mediate then go on to the court system for an ultimate decision. Cape Mediation is seeking interested volunteers. All mediators take a 32 hour course, and then must complete a practicum with intensive skills training. Mediators are neutral parties who must follow a prescribed process.
