Traditionally, the BB/BS program works to establish "community-based" relationships between adults and children (ages 7 to 12) from single-parent families and who are often at-risk youth. A new BB/BS program is being targeted that will be "site-based"; that is, adults paired with youth and meeting once a week at the school itself.
