GUEST SPEAKER: JENNIFER H. TRUE, BRIDGEWATER STATE UNIVERSITY - CAPE COD

Phil Morris introduced Jennifer True, Director of <u>Bridgewater State University (BSU) Cape Cod</u> in South Yarmouth, located at the former Laurence C. MacArthur Elementary School. She was appointed to the role in September 2014 and has since overseen the opening of this satellite campus, which just opened in midJanuary.

Jennifer has over 12 years' experience in higher education, mostly developing relationships with key stakeholders from business, non-profit, and government sectors to determine the academic programming needs that would support economic growth in the region of Southeastern Massachusetts. Most recently, she was the Director of the Workforce Education Resource Center at Cape Cod Community College. Previously, Jennifer worked at Tufts University and Bridgewater State University, where she started her higher education career after earning her Master's Degree in Public Administration.

Jennifer outlined some of the history of Bridgewater State (175 years old) and how the new local campus ("*right down the street*") came to be. She outlined plans for phased-in operations; renovations; academic and student services; license, certification, and degree programs; and partnerships with the community and with Cape Cod Community College. Starting with a cohort of nine students, BSU is striving for a seamless experience and real help to Cape students.

She is also a full time doctoral student, in her first year of a PhD program in Higher Education Administration at UMASS Boston, and is a former member (4 years) of the Rotary Club of Plymouth.
