

The department is also responsible for the enforcement of State building codes for Handicapped Regulations, Town Zoning Bylaws, Plumbing code, Gas code, and Electric code. In addition, Inspectional Services include both the Building and Health Departments.

Mark has been in the Yarmouth position about four years with prior experience in Duxbury and other communities. He discussed aspects of permitting, awareness of code changes, written zoning opinions, and community engagement. He undertook a cogent session of Q & A.
