
#### RISING STAR: CAMDEN MAZZONI, DENNIS-YARMOUTH REGIONAL H.S.

However, his presentation to the Yarmouth Rotary was centered on another passion of his: Ocean Conservancy – with particular interest in shark conservation and the sharks of New England. He has been diving and photographing sharks for 25 years. He is particularly pleased to been a contributor to the National Geographic Magazine's edition of July 2016 and its coverage of sharks and their conservation.

**Dr. Burns** placed particular emphasis to great white sharks in local waters, but he added additional perspectives about other shark species that can be found locally: basking, tiger, blue dog, mako, and scalloped hammerhead. He does his diving as a free dive (that is, without scuba gear), which adds both a degree of difficulty as well as closeness - all in an ongoing effort toward research and understanding. Seemingly, the span of new information he presented was embracing and ardent.
