• **Jim Saben** – a Honduras truck project (part of the Clean Water for the World) and a planned fundraiser August 23 in support of that truck.



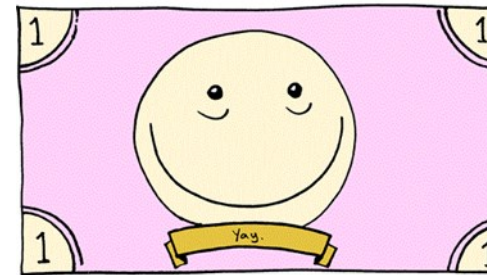
• **Mike Riley** – a plan to follow the lives of a student or two from India.
