- **Medical Minute** – Dr. Bruce gave an update on 3 medical related items: shingles vaccine, ticks, and Polio. Regarding shingles, make sure all children are vaccinated from the shingles. Regarding ticks – check often and make sure to avoid getting bit! And for Polio – it was contained to the border of Pakistan and Afghanistan. An outbreak has occurred in Papa New Guinea. The Government and UNESCO are doing mass vaccinations. Until we stamp it out everywhere, it can happen anywhere. Make sure kids/grandkids are vaccinated for polio.

- **Speaker** – Jonathan Thompson, who is also known as the “Mayor of Cape Cod”.
