MEDICAL MINUTE FROM DR. BRUCE GORDON


Dr. Bruce Gordon's

Medical Minute concerned the national crisis of the threat to the lives and hives of honeybees. While the source of bee die-off appears to be combination of factors coming together at the wrong time, a primary culprit is most likely the new



predominate class of insecticides, called neonicotinoids, which accumulate in plants as persistent agents, which in turn negatively affect the navigational, and immune systems of pollinating honeybees. This chain-of-events renders the bees back in the hives more susceptible to parasites and harmful bacteria. Neonicotinoids are a class of neuro-active insecticides chemically similar to nicotine. The neonicotinoid family includes acetamiprid, clothanidin, imidacloprid, ni tepyram, nithiazine, thiacloprid, and thiamethoxam.
