GUEST SPEAKER: BOB KELLY, YARMOUTH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Barbara Adams introduced Guest Speaker Bob Kelly, a Trustee of The Historical Society of Old Yarmouth (HSOY), and who is a tenth generation descendent from David Killea of Yarmouth. Bob is also a researcher and writer of the local history of South Yarmouth with a heavy concentration in the subjects of genealogy, salt works, Quakers, and the Native Americans of the area. Bob is currently CEO for Dennis East International.

With the 2017 Yarmouth Town Meeting support for improvements at Indian Memorial Park (123 Indian Memorial Drive, South Yarmouth), the public interest has been renewed about the significant and poignant stories of the original Native American who pre-dated the English settlers, but gradually were reduced in number and succumbed more to small pox outbreaks than any other cause. They continued to live in Yarmouth until the "last survivors" were memorialized with an inscribed stone atop a cairn on the slope within the Indian Memorial. **Bob** provided additional background about life, relationships, and research gaps still to be uncovered.
