Dean Sherman presented friend and neighbor, **Hank Teuwen**, who serves as a very active volunteer (and web master) at one of the most exceptional historical gems in Yarmouth, the Taylor-Bray Farm. **Hank** highlighted results of the archeological dig continuing at the site under the auspices of the Plymouth Archeological Rediscovery Project. He also went into detail about the newly restored farm house, which is having its first ever open house at the upcoming Festival (Sunday, June 14), complete with sheep shearing, farm animals, exhibits, and views from the new boardwalk out to Black Flats Marsh. **Hank** was assisted with a strong endorsement from a return visit from **Jack MacLelland**.
