## The Main Event

### PROGRAM: KRISTEN O'MALLEY, THE CAPE COD FOUNDATION

Guest Speaker **Kristen O'Malley** is Executive Director of The Cape Cod Foundation. Their mission statement states, "The Cape Cod Foundation builds permanent charitable resources for community betterment through informed grant making and civic leadership." Established in 1989, the Foundation has been building a permanent community endowment to benefit Cape Cod through scholarships (over \$37 million to over 2000 students since 2010) and grants to local nonprofit organizations (impacting schools and parents, art and culture, recreation and youth development, community improvement and safety, medical and health care, and more).

The Foundation does all this while maintaining sound long-term investment policies (looking for 6.8% return) and a rolling spending policy average of 3½%. **Kristen O'Malley** joined the staff of The Cape Cod Foundation in 2004 and assumed her present leadership role in 2013. A native Cape Coder, she has been an active member of a multitude of local organizations dealing with children and families, business development, philanthropy and grant making, and networking leadership.

**Kristin** was present to introduce a new community resource tool from the Foundation, namely CONNECT Cape Cod. In partnership with the Urban Institute's Center for Charitable Statistics, the Foundation created this online tool as a web-based, central access point for community resources and information, which can provide data, knowledge, interactive tools, and topic-specific links to the Cape communities and stakeholders.

It is with great pleasure that we announce that Barry was selected as one of the twenty-six finalists and was selected as the GRAND PRIZE winner at Thursdays luncheon. In Barry's name, the Yarmouth Food Pantry will receive \$25,000 from the New England Patriots Charitable Foundation.
