SPECIAL PROGRAM – BREAKFAST MEETING WITH THE D-Y INTERACT CLUB IN THE HIGH SCHOOL LIBRARY

The May 30th Yarmouth Rotary meeting was held in the library of the D-Y Regional High School and organized entirely under the auspices and leadership of the D-Y Interact Club. As has become customary, the Interact students did not disappoint. The Rotary members were left with the distinct impression that “*the future is in good hands.*”

Interact Club **President** Kristen Buotte started the morning off with welcoming remarks, followed by the customary opening activities and a sequence of Rotary announcements. She then introduced the Interact Club officers, who in turn spoke of their own personal reflections as well as some of the various projects undertaken by Interact this past school year.

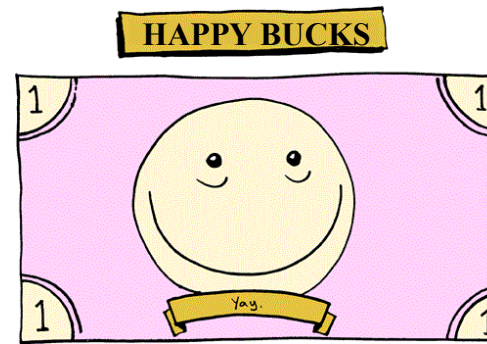
Treasurer Michaela Donohue discussed the Interact annual Holly Young Memorial Volleyball Tournament in which they raised \$468 towards the Holly Young Memorial Scholarship for a graduating D-Y volleyball player. **Secretary Aurea Nunes** outlined aspect of their annual Gingerbread House Building Contest, with the funds raised being donated to Habitat for Humanity. **Vice-President Kayla Ralston** spoke of their club’s return to success with the Linus Project – the creation of 20 blankets, which they shipped to the Snowball Express (a four-day camp for children who had lost a parent serving in the military).

The Interact officers for next year were brought up and introduced: **Orla Coughlan** (Vice-

President), **Mike Knell** (Treasurer), **Jessica Hanlon** (Secretary), **Adrienne Tardif** (President). **Adrienne** spoke of her three years in Interact, starting in the 8th grade with her father’s “assistance.” She noted, “*I hope to continue traditions of the events we have done every year and work with you to make them bigger and better. Thank you!*”

President Buotte brought the joint meeting to a close with references to additional projects, such as DY Cares Day, the Rotary Christmas Party, and the Relay for Life team of Interact members. She poignantly expressed the bittersweet nuances of concluding her D-Y and Interact commitments. “*I owe a lot to this club and the people I have encountered through it. There is much to learn outside of the classroom when you’re involved in something outside of the classroom...I am most humbled by the spirit of those around me.*”

“*And I know I speak for everyone when I say that those of us in Interact are champions of many worthy causes and of many people we will never meet but who needed our help just the same...So I thank you for all the opportunities you’ve given us to better ourselves by doing good for others. Because, without the creation of this Interact years ago and your continued support since, none of what we have done and what we want to do would be possible. Thank you.*”
