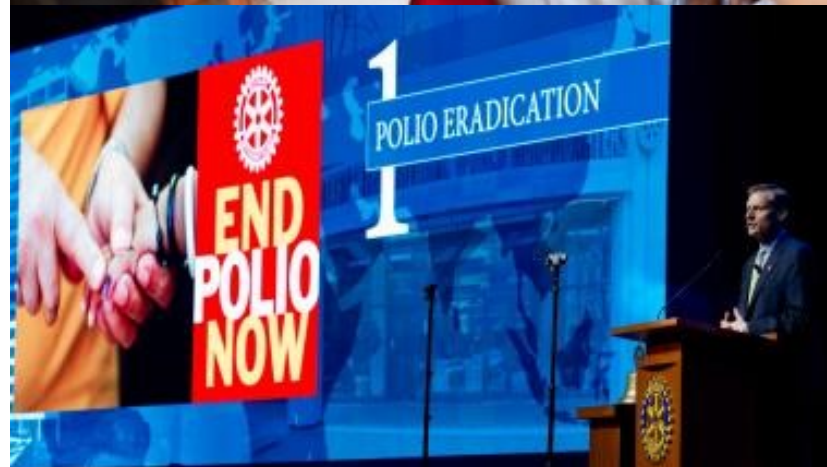
DISTRICT 7950 May 19—21

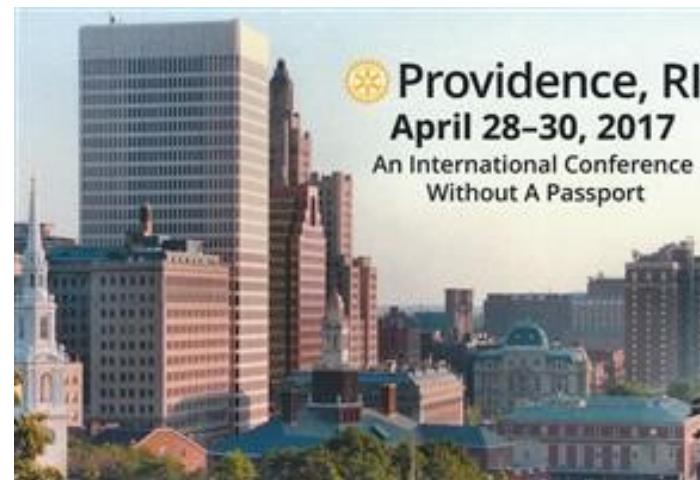
