Guest Speaker:

Dave Akin introduced Office Nick Pasquarosa the DYRHS School Resource Officer from the YPD. Nick has been a YPD officer for 31 years and the last 24 years has served as the School Resource Officer at DYRHS. As he says it is the “Best Job in Law Enforcement”.

The job of a School Resource Officer is a completely different from that of a regular officer. The resource officer needs to be completely available, be approachable and build relationships between the students and the police. The three main reasons for a resource officer are education, specialized counseling and law enforcement.

The position of Resource Officer began at DYRHS in March of 1987 when then Officer Steven Xiarhos (now Deputy Chief) assumed his post as the SRO. This partnership has now continued for over 30 years. The SRO program at DYRHS has grown to be the longest running program in Southeastern Massachusetts and has expanded to include other schools in the district and serve as a model to other communities trying to establish their own program. Nick told the story of a female student that came to him and said that she wanted to become a police officer, not just a police officer but a Yarmouth Police Officer. So he worked with her, having her attend the YPD Citizens training and working at the Police Station. Whenever she finished a training or assignment she would always come back for more. In addition, he helped her to get into Fitchburg State, that offers a Police Science Major and helped her to get a YPD scholarship and also a Yarmouth Rotary Scholarship to attend college. She has finished her first year with a 3.4 GPA and is looking forward to next year at college. He goes on to state “She is the
