GUEST SPEAKER: JR MELL, BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS OF CAPE COD & THE ISLANDS

Dave Akin was a Big Brother from 1989 to 2001. He used the upbeat story of his successful association with his Little Brother as his lead-in to introducing **JR Mell**, the Regional Director of the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Cape Cod and the Islands. JR has been has been at the helm for the past two years. The BB BS of CC & the Islands is a member of the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Massachusetts Bay family. They are the only one-to-one youth serving and mentoring organization in the area. They have been around for over 42 years and serve more than 300 kids in the community, 29 in Yarmouth itself.

JR outlined aspects of their 5-year growth plan, as well as the increased use site-based mentoring, such as in the D-Y schools. The partnerships with the Yarmouth Police Department ("Bigs in Blue") and with the Massachusetts Maritime Academy continue as success stories. The program's impact mission is to help children in under-resourced families to thrive by providing one-to-one transformational relationships with caring adult mentors. The kids themselves have expressed the results: 76% said they learned right from wrong from their Big Brother; 90% said their relationship with their Big helped them make better choices throughout their childhood; 77% reported doing better in school because of their Big Brother. As JR summed it up, "Donate, volunteer, or advocate."
