The Main Event

PROGRAM: DR. BILLY ROBERTS, DIVERSITY IN Rotary

Guest Speaker Dr. Billy Roberts is President of the Barnstable Sunrise Rotary Club, which meets Mondays, 7 am, at the Optimist Café, 134 Rte. 6A, Yarmouthport (the other Rotary club that meets in Yarmouth). Billy had to go all the way to the RI Convention to have a first meeting with Rotary neighbors Tammy and Jim. Since then the crossing of paths between the clubs has been frequent and beneficial, a story of "greeting and engagement." He is on the District Membership Committee, with its goal to promote growth. Discussion of membership growth leads to the connection with membership diversity.

As Billy noted, "I love Rotary and its commitment to better life." Yet, he pointed out, historically Rotary is an "exclusive" organization, with the perspective that folks have to be invited in to become members. Therefore, the question can be perceived in this way: Are the communities that have Rotary Clubs being representative of those communities through the membership of our clubs? Do the clubs reflect the communities that we serve? The definition of diversity is inclusive and incorporates the variations within age, gender, background, and orientation, to mention a few examples.

The Yarmouth Rotary is one of the most successful clubs when it comes to growth and community service. Yet, even here, is there room for improvement? What of those who are not yet reflected in membership? If a club wants good people, then members have to open their eyes from the start to identify those who need to be invited in order to diversify membership and broaden perspectives.
