PROGRAM SPEAKER: BETH WADE, CHAMP HOMES, INC.

Kevin Lennon introduced Elizabeth (Beth) Hardy Wade, as of January, the new Executive Director of CHAMP Homes after the retirement of long-time Club friends, Paul and Carolyn Hebert. Beth, a Chatham native with a long lineage of Chatham forebears, is a graduate of Cape Cod Community College and Emmanuel College in Boston. Beth has long been a passionate advocate for the twinned needs of Affordable Housing and Economic Development. In addition to her work at CHAMP Homes, she has taken an active role with a number of local non-profit organizations; include the Friends of Chatham Affordable Housing, the Chatham Chamber of Commerce, and the Community Development Partnership.

As her introductory visit to the Yarmouth Rotary on behalf of CHAMP Homes, Beth outlined her passage into this new role by dividing her story into three parts, starting with a very personal and powerful story about her late, twenty-year old son, Jamie and how his death led her to CHAMP Homes. From the start of Paul's touching letter of invitation, her involvement grew from volunteer to Board member to President. She outlined how the work at CHAMP Homes is a community effort (including the Yarmouth Rotary) and made comparisons with the vicissitudes of community "midwifery."
