### RISING STAR – KENDALL ARCHAMBEAU FROM CAPE COD TECH

### PROGRAM

**Kevin Lennon**, Chair of the May Program Committee introduced as **Beth Biro**, Forensic Sexual Abuse Consultant and Forensic Interviewer from Children's Cove as Guest Speaker in a return visit. Founded in 1997 as a grass roots Child Advocacy Center, Children's Cove is a Barnstable county agency whose focus has evolved from mostly prosecution to an agency that is victim centered. Their mission: to provide coordinated and comprehensive multidisciplinary services to child victims of sexual abuse/serious physical abuse and their families.

As **Beth** noted, there is still a need for gathering evidence, but with only six full time staff, increasing awareness and prevention have taken on increased importance. April was Assault Awareness Month and representative pinwheels were much in view. 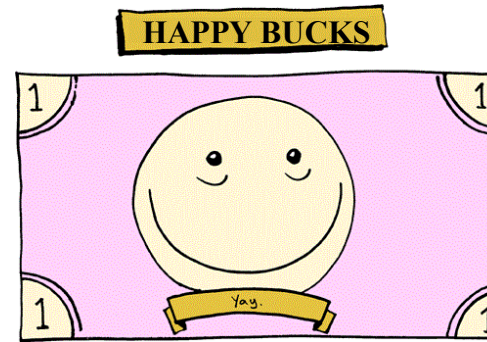
