Guest Speaker Tammy Saben - Chair of the Board of Trustees at 4C's among many other community organizations that she volunteers her time. Tammy presented regarding Rotary and "Dared us to Lead". Tammy comes from a large family, her father being the youngest of 10. They came from Greece and she learned work ethic from them as a 3rd generation Cape Codder. Lessons from her upbringing included always be truthful, respect elders, stick together, on the way up, be kind to those that you pass, and hold your head high and look the world straight in the eye, always give thanks and then give back, and compare your journey to only yours. Her business has grown to be able to service over 170 companies, half of which are non-profits. The successes of Tammy and her business come from the "7 Habits of Highly Effective People" by Stephen Covey. Know your epithet, think of how you want to be remembered and work to create the epithet you want. She then quoted the Bible, "to whom much is given, much is required."

In Dave Akin's prayer, he mentioned how many experiences and how his life has been impacted by Rotary. Tammy echoed this sentiment and spoke of traveling around the world with Rotary, things that otherwise wouldn't have happened. From the Guatemala service trip for Clean Water, International Conventions, and helping people locally.

In closing, she quoted Chuck Swindoll - "Life is 10% what happens to you and 90% how you to react to it." She also read to us his writing on "Attitude".
