The Main Event

SPEAKER: BARRY CLAYMAN, “CELEBRATING VOLUNTEERISM”

PDG Barry Clayman’s commitment to Rotary and the spirit of volunteerism has been both long and deep, starting with his membership into the Rotary Club of Sharon in 1978, and continuing unabated to the present. He was the Sharon Club President in 1983-1984 and 1992-1993, District Governor 2000-2001, and has been a member of the Yarmouth Club since 2007. His Rotary noteworthy leadership contributions of many years to District 7950 have included the International Avenue of Service Committee, the District Youth Exchange Community, and the World Community Service Committee. In 1995, the District presented **Barry Clayman** with the “Dr. Percy Hodgson Award for Exceptional Service.”

Barry presented a personal retrospective of the range and consequences of the 38 Rotary projects and matching grants within 15 countries that he has observed, all of them commencing from the dedication of volunteerism. He has remained a compelling advocate for the function, utilization, and progress of the Foundation of Rotary International, as well as the necessary endeavor of engaging as many local Rotary Clubs as possible, regardless of membership size. In addition, **Barry’s** commitment to community volunteerism has also remained robust, as witness to his multifaceted impact to the mission and vigor of the Yarmouth Food Pantry. On top of all these examples of dedicated volunteerism, **Barry’s** personal model of giving through blood donations has topped 28 gallons.
