GUEST SPEAKER: KATHY ZAGZEBSKI, NATIONAL MARINE WILDLIFE CENTER

Kathy Zagzebski is the President and Executive Director of the National Marine Life Center, headquartered in Bourne. Her organization is an independent, non-profit 501(c)(3) marine animal hospital, “*Caring for Stranded Marine Animals*.” NMLC is also a science and education center dedicated to (1) rehabilitating for release stranded sea turtles, seals, dolphins, porpoises, and small whales, and (2) advancing scientific knowledge and education in marine wildlife health and conservation.

Kathy is a magna cum laude graduate from Augustana College, and a Master’s graduate from Duke University. Her background includes working for the Marine Mammal Center in California and the Coastal Management Program in Georgia and volunteer service for a variety of marine mammal projects in California, Hawaii, North Carolina, Georgia, and Massachusetts.



Locally, **Kathy** is an alumna of the Cape Leadership Institute of Cape Cod and the Islands and serves on the boards of • the Bourne Financial Development Corporation, • the Cape Cod Technology Council, • the Massachusetts Marine Educators’ Association, and • the Philanthropy Partners of the Cape and Islands. She also serves on the advisory committees of • the Environmental Technology Program at Upper Cape Cod Regional Technical High School and • the Marine Biology Program at the Norfolk Agricultural High School.

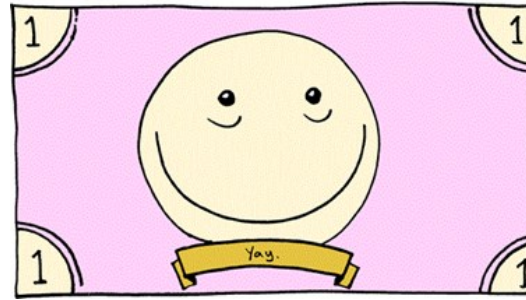
