The Main Event

Guest Speaker – Brian Braginton Smith on Economic Development

Brian addressed the club regarding economic development on Cape Cod with a global and technology based viewpoint. He mentioned that the sustainable world population is 1.5 billion, and we are over 7 billion currently and moving towards 10 billion. The question he posed was, “how are we going to sustain this?” One of the issues on the Cape is the historical development has been sprawl, which he defined as housing that is spread out, which causes isolation and difficult for all areas to access transportation. In addition, it is not an efficient use of the landscape. Interestingly, he stated that 75% of world population lives near the coast and this will and has created a strain on many coastal communities such as ours. “How are we going to adapt to the need to grow? Wastewater is one area where we need to look at it as a resource and capture the maximum value to achieve a more sustainable model. The challenge is to turn wastewater into a renewable energy such as using it for heating,” said Brian. “We need to increase the overall dynamic of population and increase commercial activity so funding does not fall as heavily onto residential funding.”

Brian concluded by stating, “The reason we are here, in Rotary, is because we innately feel and want to do things to help others. ‘Be the inspiration’ is what we need to be doing, because it is essential for the survival of our community.”
