Marleen Spengler (MBA, RN-BC, CMC), is a Geriatric Care Manager and a very active member of the Board of Directors of The Parkinson Support Network of Cape Cod (PSN). The Parkinson Support Network of Cape Cod is a branch of the American Parkinson Disease Association, Massachusetts Chapter (www.apdma.org). Right now, over 2000 residents on Cape Cod are living with Parkinson's Disease (PD) and over 1 million in the U. S. alone, with 60,000 being diagnosed each year.

Founded in 2008 by Joyce Ginouves (President), PSN is a network of consumers, health and human service providers, and organizations collaborating to provide services across the Cape for people living with Parkinson's disease and for their families/care partners. The PSN programming on Cape Cod includes educational symposia, specialized art and movement programs, information and referral, support group services, as well as an annual Dinner Dance and Entertainment
