#### GUEST SPEAKER: FRANK FREDERICKSON, YAR-MOUTH CHIEF OF POLICE

YPD Officer Kevin Lennon introduced Chief of Police, Frank Frederickson, with the reflection that the Chief Frederickson's 37 years in the YPD distinguishes him as Yarmouth's longest active municipal employee. The Chief himself focused outward with thanks to the Yarmouth Rotary's recent luncheon for public safety responders and with department updates such as the 7% drop in "calls for service" from the previous year. He attributes the measures and rates of crime going down as due to hard work, technology, and innovative programs such as the community's Crime Watch program. There are 125 Crime Watch captains within the town – now with the additional trained-owner participation of some of the 3000 registered dogs (each participating dog being awarded their own "Crime Watch bandana").


