### MEMORIAL NOTE – ANDREA PARKER, WIFE OF DON PARKER

*In 1989, the Yarmouth Rotary Club was chartered as a direct result of the efforts of the Rotary Club of Hyannis to form a new in neighboring Yarmouth. **Don Parker** was the Hyannis Club President at that time and instrumental in Yarmouth Rotary formation. He was the author of the Club’s Welcoming and Closing Songs. He and his wife **Andrea** maintained strong ties to the Yarmouth Club over the years, not to mention deep friendships with a number of Cape Cod residents, such as **Bob** and **Sue Huckman**, among others. **Don’s** last visit to the Yarmouth Rotary was in September 2012. The following notice is a condensed version that appeared in the Cape Cod Times, September 24, 2014.*

**Andrea Lucas Parker**, age 85, formerly of West Dennis, Cape Cod, presently of Amelia Island, FL, passed away on Saturday, September 20, 2014. She grew up in Newton, attended Newton High School, and was a graduate of Beaver Country Day School in Brookline MA. She married her husband, **Donald Kempton Parker**, in 1951. They remained together for 63 years.

Throughout their life together and having three children, the **Parkers** lived in Canton, Wellesley, and Cohasset, MA, before buying her family’s rambling summer home and moving to Cape Cod in the late 1970s. While living on Cape Cod, **Andrea** operated a Bed and Breakfast out of their personal home. She and **Don** later owned and operated the Centerville General Store. In 1997, after having wintered on Amelia Island for seven years, she and her husband became permanent residents.

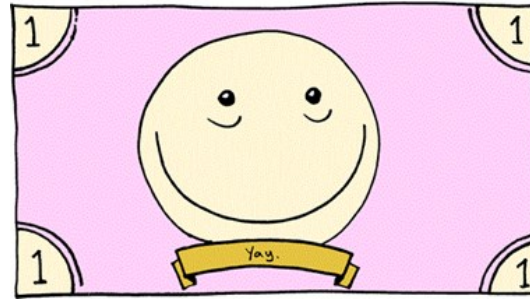
