Guest Speaker District Governor Stephen Albright -Thank you for the opportunity, it was this club that trusted and nominated him to be able to be a District Governor. **Membership:** Steve began his presentation by speaking on Membership and some of the challenges Rotary is facing internationally, district wide, and in our own club. We lost 278 or 12% of membership in our own district in the 5 past years. These numbers are not sustainable. 80% of our members are 60 years of age or older. It is up to all of us and it is our responsibility to further and grow the Rotary mission. Diverse by classification, anything or anyone that is different is great. The goal is to grow by net 2 new members each year for the next 5 years. Make membership everyone's priority, not just membership chair. If you haven't made membership a priority, why haven't you? It is not easy and focusing on it for a year or two will not work. We need to focus on younger members, including alternative meeting formats and times. From RI President Mark Maloney, "We need to foster a culture where Rotary does not compete with a family, but rather compliments it." We need to turn our clubs irresistible so that people come to us and line up to join. "Although we might ruffle a few feathers along the way, we need to be the flamingo of change." We have lost zones, districts and clubs in North America.

Foundation: Steve then spoke regarding the Rotary Foundation and the importance of eradicating polio globally. The funds that fund global and district grants are from individual donations. 50% of the funds donated to the Rotary Foundation goes to the Global Fund and the other 50% come back to the district as District Grants. I am asking that that \$2 per week, \$100 a year towards the Rotary Foundation is the goal for each Rotarian.
