Later, the idea for Flower Angels emerged with the plan to repurpose flowers that would ordinarily be thrown away into small acts of kindness, in honor of her mother, and with the help of her friend Karen and her daughter Mara, Flower Angels was created with the hope of making a difference in the lives of the elderly residents of Cape Cod. Today the organization has grown with almost one hundred volunteers and many organizations who are delighted to help. Suzanne is proud to say “That Flower Angels has warmed the hearts of all it touches as it spread joy one bouquet at a time”. Flower Angels USA was founded on the idea that beautiful repurposed flowers and lonely people were a match made in heaven. With over 2000 nursing home and hospice beds on Cape Cod, the flower angels are thrilled to uplift spirits by bringing bouquets of sunshine and joy to our elderly.
