## The Main Event

### PROGRAM SPEAKER: ROBERT SANBORN, SUPER-INTENDENT, CAPE COD TECHNICAL H.S.

The last opportunity for Superintendent Bob Sanborn had to speak to the Yarmouth Rotary about Cape Cod Tech's building project was last January 13. In a return visit, he continued his role as the conveyer-in-chief of updates, news, and projections; this time with the assistance of an-depth, four-page flyer distributed in addition to his PowerPoint presentation. By now, CC Tech Building Committee progress has reached the MSBA (*Massachusetts School Building Authority*) Module 4: Schematic Design Phase

In August the MSBA Board of Directors approved the project scope and budget for a *new* Cape Cod Regional Technical High School. The total project cost estimate is \$128,062,881, which is a \$14 M decrease from estimates during the Feasibility Phase. The District – the 12 Cape towns from Mashpee to Provincetown, including Yarmouth – will be responsible for approximately \$86 M of these costs. The District now seeks approval of this project with a District-wide vote on October 24, 2017 “to authorize the debt for the project” in order to proceed to the Funding the Project Phase.

(Add-on note: the Town of Barnstable conducted their portion of a Prop 2½ debt exclusion special vote on September 19. The result was an approval margin of 1749 to 890, which was 7.8% turnout of the 33,597 registered voters in Barnstable.)
