The Main Event

Guest Speaker: Dr. Bruce Gordon, "Advanced Planning for the End of Life"

Dr. Bruce Gordon began his presentation on a somber subject with the lugubrious title of "Advanced Planning for the End of Life" by starting with a particular phrase projected on the screen, "100% of Americans will die."

He had our attention.

Starting with the observation that "people don't plan," he set the stage for his main point; make your own end-of-life plans and decisions while you can before death or dementia take away your power of choice and judgement and give them to a probate court for settlement. He discussed four key documents: • wills, • health care proxy, • MOLST (Massachusetts Medical Orders for Life-Sustaining Treatment), and • Durable General Power of Attorney.

Bruce outlined the pros and cons, along with the means of preparing these documents.

He also reviewed relevant optional documents: • Living Trusts, • Testamentary Trusts, • Insurance Trusts, and • Second-to-Die Life Insurance. He concluded with an examination of the benefits of Writing a Last Letter, with its Seven Tasks, (perhaps even eight).
