Membership Committee Update – The Membership Committee has come up with a retention and information brochure that will be presented to the club shortly. They will meet on 9/21 after the meeting and will provide the update soon.

Guest Speakers Carole Woodbury and Ken Jenks – A New Intermediate-Middle School for Dennis-Yarmouth Students -

The Journey - In 2008, a study was conducted to assess the physical conditions of all DY Schools. In 2011, the district submitted a statement of interest for Mattacheese and Wixon to be renovated. In 2013, the district reorganized buildings and grades 4-8 across the district. In 2016, the school district received an invitation from the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) to join the application process, however, asked the district to combine the 2 statement of interests/projects to one project/plan. This ultimately will complete 2 schools for grades 4-7 into one single school project. On September 12, 2018, the MSBA finished the feasibility study. The process was extensive and included a visioning process that comprised of parents, teachers, and the community at large. The building needs to last for 50+ years and must be adaptable to change over time as technology and needs change. This will be a sustainable green school district/community. "We are hoping that this school will produce the power that it needs. The plan is to incorporate the latest technology, yet also have a small school feel with large school pride," stated Carole. "Of paramount importance is safety – the school must be safe for students, yet also allow the community to have access to it and be able to use the building for events, meetings, and more." One of the major components for MSBA approval was the educational plan. The district had to answer the question, "How will you do things differently with building versus building for sake of building?" An important milestone is the public vote coming up in December.
