These directions were provided by Rich Harwood about 2004. They are believed to be still good although some details may have changed, e.g. is Raschel's still open?

To circumvent the traffic on Route 1 for Patriots parking for those not wishing to take 95 all the way to Walpole and then turn around.

North bound on Rte. 1 you will take a right on Rte 140 (immediately after the Foxboro State Police barracks). Proceed on 140 towards Foxboro, staying to the right at the bottom of exit. Proceed towards Foxboro Center you will be looking to make a left hand turn on Chestnut Street (the turn comes up right after passing the Raschel's Mall on your left) You can usually see 1 or 2 police cruisers parked on the street. After making that left, traveling only about 50 feet, you should see a road block on your left for access to North Street. This is the street that actually goes behind the stadium and connects with Rte 1 again in S. Walpole at the Citgo Station. Only Local traffic is permitted during game days.

Some make it a point to show the policeman stationed at the road block a Rotary Directory, informing him/her that the driver is a volunteer for Rotary parking cars at Foxboro Medical Center on Rte 1 with the Foxboro Rotary Club. They have always let us pass through. Some times they have you go down to the next street on your left (Payson St.), not to worry, the street connects with North Street about a mile down.

Stay on North Street until you come to the lights on Rte 1. Take a right at the lights and the Parking lot is up on your right.
