Information and Reference Guide

IF YOU HAVE BECOME A VICTIM

- ___ Contact your local Police Department to report the incident and obtain a case #.
- ___ Contact the Department of Labor and Training to stop claim by either Calling them, emailing them, or faxing them your information.
- ___ Contact the Federal Trade Commission to report the theft and receive instructions.
- ___ Contact a credit agency of your choice to either put an alert or freeze on Credit report.
- ___ Print hard copies of all evidence and documentation associated with the theft.
- ___ Monitor all credit information for any further theft or discrepancies.
