Donna is a member (and board chair) of the **Vermont Haiti Project.** Donna talked about the water filtration project her group undertakes and funds. The problems surrounding potable drinking water in Haiti are epidemic. Working alongside Haitian professionals, they build water filters with concrete, river rocks and sand. Aside from installing and maintaining the filters, the staff in Haiti also educates residents on hygiene, health, and clean water usage.

The group also has established a rural (7 hours by car from Port au Prince) **Vocational Training Center** and contributes to the success of a **school and children's center** in Port au Prince.
