Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Applicant shall be resident of Jamestown, Rhode Island;
- 2. Applicant shall be a high school senior in good standing, at any high school or high school homeschool program; and,
- 3. Applicant must have plans to attend an accredited college, university or vocational school to pursue an academic decree or official certification after graduating from high school.

Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. The deadline for completed application forms (along with any other attachments or supplemental information) is **April 30, 2024**.
- 2. Applicant may continue answers on a separate sheet of paper if needed;
- 3. Applicants must write their answers to the application essay question without assistance from parents, teachers, tutors, friends, etc.
- 4. Applicants must scan completed application documents into one PDF document, and email it to the Jamestown Rotary Scholarship Selection Committee, % Committee Chair Lisa Molinari at rotary02835@gmail.com on or before the April 30, 2024 deadline.
- 5. Scholarship decisions will be announced on May 15, 2023 via email.
- 6. The scholarship winner will be required to attend a Rotary dinner, where he or she will read the winning essay and answer questions. Scholarship check will be presented at that time.
- 7. The 2024 Jamestown Rotary Scholarship is a one-time grant in the amount of \$2,000.00, paid directly to the scholarship winner for college, university or vocational school expenses.
