Who/What is Rotary?

- •International network of community volunteers
- -Members are business, professional, and community leaders
- -Provide humanitarian service, build good will
- -Over 33,000 clubs around the world
- -Over 1.2 million Rotarians world wide
- -Started Youth Exchange in 1929

What is Youth Exchange?

- •Opportunity for high school students to live in foreign country for up to a year
- -Learn new way of living
- -Become skilled with new language
- -Be an ambassador teach about our country
- -Develop new set of international friends
- -Learn more about yourself
- –Broaden your world view

The Program Newport offers:

- •Usually last one school year
- •Live with two or three host families
- Enjoy activities with host family
- Attend school
- •Host families are carefully screened and selected by Rotary

What are the qualifications?

- •Open to high school students ages 15 18.5
- •Should be above average student
- •Demonstrate leadership in community
- •Be flexible and willing to try new things
- Act as cultural ambassador
- ·Language proficiency depends on country
- •Must by sponsored by local Rotary club
- Complete application and interview

What are the costs?

- •Costs vary with country where exchange occurs
- -Room and board is covered by host family.

The hosting club will pay a stipend of about \$100 a month

- -Typically students and parents cover following:
- •Application fee \$1,400

includes Insurance for medical, accident, and illness coverage

- •Round trip airfare
- •Travel documents like passport and visas
- Spending money, ancillary travel, tours

What countries are available?

- •As of October 2012, about 43 countries
- -Includes most of Europe, South America, some Asia and some Africa
- •On application you list your top 5 in order
- •No guarantee you will get first choice
- •Over 8,000 students participate each year
