NOTICES:

1. Paid Applications will be taken in the order received. Limit of 50 boats.
2. I.G.F.A rules will be followed unless otherwise noted.
3. Wire line can be used.
4. Only (1) Bluefish and (1) Striper per angler may be weighed in.
5. Fish weighed in must be caught on the day of the Tournament.
6. Fish to be weighed in must be at the scale 4:00 P.M., July 15, 2023, at the dock of the Wianno Yacht Club.
7. "Within Nantucket Sound" Category - fishing limited to "within Nantucket Sound" - only boats less than 26ft in length may choose to fish in this category.
8. "Open Category" for Bluefish - no limit to the fishing area
9. Striper fishing - no limit to the fishing area
10. Boats cannot begin fishing until on or after 6:00 A.M. on July 15, 2023. Lines out of the water by 2:00 P.M.
11. Channel 78A is the official channel.
12. Captain's Meeting is 5:30 P.M., Friday, July 14, 2023, at Osterville Anglers Club. Attendance is mandatory. Osterville Anglers Club, 72 Crosby Circle, Osterville, MA.
13. In the event of a tie, the first fish weighed in is the winner.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

I and my team and crew agree and understand that the Osterville-Mashpee Rotary Club and Wianno Yacht Club, its directors, officers, employees and agents (hereafter collectively referred to as OMRC/WYC) shall not be liable under any circumstances for any injuries or damages to person or property, arising out of, resulting from or in any way connected with me or my crew's participation in any tournament whether caused by any negligent act or negligent omission of OMRC/WYC, or by any other reason or cause whatsoever. In consideration of the acceptance of my and my team and crew's entry and for other good and valuable consideration received, we hereby remise, release and forever discharge OMRC/WYC and its respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns of and from all claims, suits, obligations, liabilities, losses, damages, costs or expenses which our team or our heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns may have against OMRC/WYC, arising out of, resulting from, or in any way connected with my participation in any Tournament. I understand that this release includes any claims based on any negligent act or negligent omission of OMRC/WYC.

To the fullest extent permitted by the law, my team, my crew and I hereby agree to indemnify, to defend with counsel acceptable to OMRC/WYC and to hold harmless OMRC/WYC, from and against any and all claims, suits, obligations, liabilities, losses, damages, costs or expenses including but not limited to reasonable attorney fees, suffered by OMRC/WYC or by any other person or persons, whatsoever, arising out of, resulting from or in any way connected with my participation in any tournament including any and all claims, suits, obligations, liabilities, losses, damages, costs or expenses caused in whole or in part by any negligent act or negligent omission of OMRC/WYC or anyone for whose acts OMRC/WYC may be liable regardless of whether it is caused in part by a party indemnified hereunder.

This agreement shall take effect as an instrument under seal and be binding upon and unrevocable to the benefit of my and my teams' and crew's heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.

Entrants are advised to obtain insurance covering their participation in this or any other tournament.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Rotary Club of Osterville-Mashpee Annual Bluefish Tournament was conceived with the purpose of raising funds for the benefit of over 50 charitable and civic organizations within Barnstable County; to name a few: American Red Cross, Big Brothers/Big Sisters, Cape Abilities, CC Times Needy Fund, CHAMP Homes, CHIPS House, CC YMCA, Local Libraries, and nearly 50 local and regional charities/organizations. Additionally, the Rotary Club of Osterville-Mashpee provides scholarships for a select number of graduating local seniors to the college of their selection.

The event will take place on Saturday, July 15, 2023. There is a maximum of 50 Boats that can compete for 3 first prizes. The Tournament's crystal trophy with the winners' names permanently engraved, is housed at the Osterville Anglers Club and displayed at various other public places during the year. The tournament takes place at the Wianno Yacht Club, Bridge Street, Osterville. The Captains must be at the Captains meeting the night before – Friday, July 14, 2023, at 5:30 P.M. at the Osterville Anglers Club, 72 Crosby Circle in Osterville. Anglers can begin fishing within the tournament area after 6:00 A.M. on July 15, 2023. Anglers will weigh in only one fish in each category and present it for weighing on the official scale by 2:00 P.M., from their registered boat at the Wianno Yacht Club pier.

There will be 2 Bluefish categories and 1 Striped Bass category.

- The first Bluefish category is "Within Nantucket Sound"- for boats less than 26'. Only boats less than 26' may choose to fish in this category. The fishing area will be limited to "within Nantucket Sound."
- The second Bluefish category is "Open Category" and you will be allowed to fish anywhere that you would like. If your boat is 26' or over, this is the category that you will be fishing in. If your boat is less than 26' you may fish in this category - you have to make this decision on the night of the Captain's meeting.
- The third category is for the heaviest Striper. Make sure that you follow the state rules for catching Stripers. We will have the Tournament monitoring a preselected channel and reporting results throughout the day.
- We will also have Juniors Division for those anglers under 15 years old. We will have trophies for 1st and 2nd heaviest fish in this category.

Winners will be announced, and prizes awarded under the tent during the Bar-B-Que Party to which the entire family is invited at an additional cost of \$20 each, \$7 for children. (The Bar-B-Que is included for all Anglers registered for the Tournament.) An auction, along with a raffle, will present an opportunity for everyone to have fun, socialize, and bring home some great bargains.
