### **Application for the Rotary Club of Hillsborough Fred Quick Community Service Scholarship**

[Rotary](#) brings together a global network of volunteer leaders dedicated to tackling the world's most pressing humanitarian challenges. Rotary connects 1.2 million members of more than 34,000 Rotary clubs in over 200 countries and geographical areas. Their work improves lives at both the local and international levels, from helping families in need in their own communities to working toward a polio-free world.

The [Rotary Club of Hillsborough](#) currently has approximately 40 active members from Hillsborough and surrounding communities. Members include business and professional leaders who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world. All funds raised by The Rotary Club of Hillsborough are used to support a wide variety of community service organizations, projects and causes including the local food pantry, post-secondary education scholarships, dictionaries for third-graders in our school district, families in need and support services for active military and veterans. The Rotary Club of Hillsborough meets on Wednesday, at 6:15 pm, at The Landing Restaurant in Hillsborough.

The Rotary motto is “Service Above Self.” To promote the Rotary mission in the area of education, and to honor the memory of Fred Quick, a lifelong Hillsborough resident, Rotarian, and tireless community servant, the Rotary Club of Hillsborough is offering a new scholarship beginning in 2020. The Fred Quick Community Service Scholarship is reserved for a Hillsborough resident who attends a high school, other than Hillsborough High School, and plans to attend an accredited college or trade school. (Applications for scholarships for Hillsborough High School seniors are available through the student’s guidance counselor.) The Fred Quick scholarship will be awarded to a student of high academic standing who, through volunteer work and/or extracurricular activities, has demonstrated active involvement in the local community. A letter from a teacher, guidance counselor, or the volunteer program director verifying the student’s involvement in community service is also required.

- The nature of the community service you provided
- The ways in which your service has impacted those you assisted
- The effect your community service has had on your life and why this is important to you
- The ways in which this service changed your perspective on your community

Attach a letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor or volunteer supervisor who oversaw your service.
