- c. Review and approve projects for implementation.
- d. Develop and execute contracts to ensure project implementation.



Public Art Program/Placemaking

Offers up to 50% towards assistance, not to exceed \$7,500





Calling all artists - Utility Box Art Program


- March 10, 2023: Deadline for all sketch and conceptual design submissions
