Reasons to love Rotary right now ... Reason #237: Rotarians fight disease!

A Community Cure: Partners for a Malaria-Free Zambia - an initiative founded and led by Rotary members and the recipient of Rotary's first \$2 million Programs of Scale grant

Of the five species of malaria-causing parasites, the one that's most prevalent in Africa is the deadliest. According to the World Health Organization, there were an estimated 241 million cases of malaria worldwide in 2020; with 95% of those cases in Africa — and 96% percent of the 627,000 deaths. In 2020, children under 5 accounted for about 80% of all malaria deaths in WHO's Africa region.

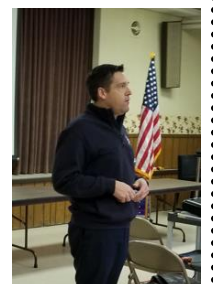
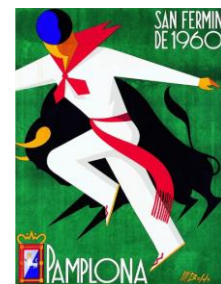


Malaria can progress to a severe form, with complications such as organ failures and abnormalities in the blood or brain. But it doesn't have to be that way. Malaria treatments exist. **Rotary is making a difference** by helping to get tests and treatments to the people who need them or who may not even realize that they need to be tested.

Prior Week: Nov 17th - Mason Pooler - Running of the Bulls Festival

The festival dates back hundreds of years and is thought to have begun in 1385. While the festival has changed over the years, the main traditions have remained the same.

All 1 million people at the Running of the Bulls wear the red & white uniform all day and all night. Tradition holds that you put on the Pañuelo (bandana) and Faja (sash) at Noon on July 6th and don't take them off until Midnight July 14th. If you don't wear the uniform – they'll assume you didn't know there was a festival going on, so be prepared to be doused with sangria on the street as a reminder.
