

Getting to know Rotary's 2023-2024 president-elect, Gordon McInally (interview excerpts)

What are your core values, and how do they shape how you lead?
 My core value can be expressed in one word, and that is "caring." I like to think that I care for people.
 Professionally as a dentist, I cared for people for many, many years. I think if the world was a more caring place, a kinder place, then it would be a much happier place and a much more peaceful place.
 Peace is one of the issues that I particularly want to see us move forward.



How can we reignite members of Rotary who appear to have "lost their spark"?

I think the way to reignite the lost spark in certain members of Rotary is to make sure that the Rotary club experience is as good as it can be and suits everybody. It's not a case of one-size-fits-all. It all comes down to the service. We are a membership organization and a service organization. It's not either/or. We need to be out there doing service, because not only will we enjoy that more, we will also see more people want to come and join us because they can see us.

What is the biggest potential you see in Rotary as an organization that has not been fully realized?

We saw a great increase in volunteerism during the pandemic. I think we have a great opportunity to connect with those people and encourage them to carry on volunteering through Rotary. I believe it's in everybody's nature to care for other people. If we can bring that out of people, and if we can build on the spirit of care that we saw during the pandemic, what a wonderful legacy.

Rotary Districts can apply for disaster response grants until June 30, 2024 to provide relief (food, water, shelter, clothing, and medicine) to refugees and other people affected by the war in Ukraine. Rotary District 6270 and the Rotary Club of Waukesha have been working to help restore power through fundraising efforts to purchase around 250 electrical generators for shelters and community centers.


