Prior Week: May 11th - History of Submarines Part Two - John Lindstedt John returned for part two of his riveting story about the Polar Transit of the USS Nautilus. A book that captures a lot of information about this incredible true story is titled "Ice Diaries."

It was a top-secret mission on the world's first nuclear-powered submarine taking a dangerous journey beneath the vast, unexplored Arctic ice cap

during the height of the Cold War. It was an important and monumental achievement. John Lindstedt is a former nuclear submarine officer having "Qualified in Submarines" in 1974. He served during the Cold War, making three deterrent patrols in the Mediterranean Sea.
