The Rotary Foundation recognizes Disease Prevention and Treatment as one of its Seven Areas of Focus. The ramifications of disease and illness extend beyond physical pain and injury. Prolonged, severe illness can lead to the loss of employment and income, impacting not only individuals but also their families. The ripple effect is felt in the overall quality of life.



One of Don's favorite stories about Rotarians as people of action comes from the efforts of a member of his first Rotary Club in Atlanta, Georgia. Fueled by the personal loss of her son to AIDS, Marion Bunch pioneered the

Rotary Action Group for Family Health and AIDS Prevention Inc (RFHA). Central to RFHA's endeavors is the Rotary Family Health Days program, a monumental medical public/private partnership—one of the world's largest.
