Last Week: Apr 25th - Mason Pooler, Shipwreck - 1715 Spanish ship



Mason's program was on the 1715 Spanish shipwreck. He discovered a Spanish coin on the coast of FL when he was vacationing. In 1715, a hurricane struck the east coast of Florida, sinking 10 Spanish treasure ships and killing nearly 1,000 people. The ships were part of the 1715 Treasure Fleet, one of the numerous Spanish treasure fleets sailing between Spain and its colonies in the Americas.

The wreck of one of these ships, Urca de Lima, is located north of Fort Pierce Inlet, 200 yards off the shore from Jack Island Park. The sunken ships lay forgotten for more than 200 years until modern treasure hunters discovered several of them. Salvage of these shipwrecks continues today.
