Christian from Dottke made another visit to our club meeting

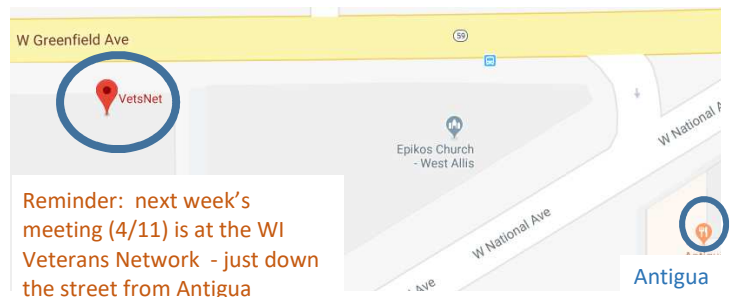


Katherine from West Allis Central reporting they are hosting an Easter Egg hunt at La Follette Park on the Saturday before Easter.
