Located in Mukwonago, Jennifer Pape founded the Willow Creek Ranch in June of 2007 to fill a growing gap in the field of physical & cognitive health services in the area. This form of therapy presents children and adults the opportunity to build self-esteem and confidence in order to fulfill their dream of riding a horse. Willow Creek Ranch operates under the standards and regulations of PATH Intl, an organization that promotes safe and effective therapeutic horseback riding throughout the United States and Canada.

At **Willow Creek Ranch**, their therapeutic riding lessons are offered by PATH Intl registered instructors, who lead lessons through riding exercises specifically designed to address and improve the rider's needs. They focus on therapeutic goals and objectives derived from the evaluation that is done prior to their first lesson. The experiences are **life-changing** for many.

#### Through riding lessons and other activities, riders develop:

- improved balance and postural alignment
- muscle strength
- head and trunk control
- eye-hand coordination
- increased range of motion
- socialization skills
- self-esteem
- self-confidence



#### Diagnoses commonly treated with therapeutic riding include:

- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHA)
- Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD)
- Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Cerebral Palsy
- Downs Syndrome

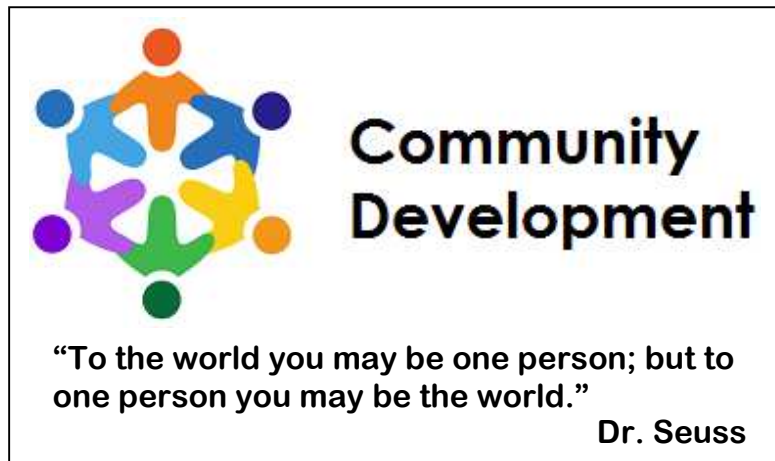
